Instructions for Reviewers

1. The article should be original writing that enhances and contributes to the existing knowledge in the given subject area. Original review articles and surveys are acceptable, even if new data/concepts are not presented, but there must be a clear advance over existing work.

****If you have any concerns about plagiarism, please alert the Associate Editor or article lead administrator immediately. Please do not run the manuscript through any plagiarism software. Each article submitted to BRD Engineering Journal is scanned for plagiarism and evaluated during our thorough prescreening process.**

2. Results reported have not been submitted or published elsewhere (although expanded versions of conference publications and preprints are eligible for submission).

3. Experiments, statistics, and other analyses are performed to a high technical standard and are described in sufficient detail.

4. Conclusions are presented in an appropriate fashion and are supported by the data.

5. The article is written in Standard English with correct grammar.

6. Appropriate references to related prior published works must be included.

7. The article falls within the BRD Engineering Journal scope.
